Jefferson County Park Hop

Clifty Park

- Climb the observation tower. How many steps did it take you to reach the top?
- Walk into the Inn. What large taxidermy bird do you see?
- At Big Clifty Falls, a centennial stone has a quote on it. Whose quote is it?

Heritage Park

- Walk around the park. How many marten bird houses do you count hanging up?
- Visitors like to use a painting here for a photo. Find a design painted on a concrete structure. What is it?

Heritage Trail

• How many benches are on the hillside section of the Heritage Trail?

Webster Woods Nature Preserve

- Walk down the gravel road to the walking trail. What is the trail called?
- Take a walk along the trail. Do you hear any frogs?

Bicentennial Park

- Count the number of brick columns around the perimeter. How many are there?
- How many large wind sculptures are in the middle of the park? Take your best guess at how tall they are!

Saluda Township Park

- Frogs call or "peep" this time of year, celebrating Spring. Are any peeping today?
- Dandelions are usually the first flowers to bloom each year. Can you find any?

Hanover College Trails

- Who are the Hanover College campus trails named after?
- Guess how old the trees in this forest are. Hint: most blew down in a tornado in 1974.

Gaines Park

- What year is featured on the old Broadway High School sign?
- How many swings will you find at the park?

Hanover Town Park

- How many different playgrounds are at the park?
- Look for animals. Do you see any wildlife?
- How many slides are on the big playground?

Hargan Matthew's Park

- How many swings are in the park?
- Climb to the top of the playground. How many steps did you take to reach the top?

Johnson Lake

- How many fitness stops are there around the lake? Try one out!
- What animals, plants, or insects do you see on the lake trail? Can you draw one?

- How many bases are on the field? Take a run around them!

- What will keep you warm, with a view has six sides but blocks two?
- What lets you be on the water but won't row away?

Lorenz Park

- Name one of the plants or animals listed on the play equipment.
 - How many benches are there?

Skate Park, Park for all Children, & Rucker Park

- What color is the longest slide at the Playground for all Children?
- How many ramp sections will you find at the Skate Park?
- Name 2 sports that are played at the Rucker Sports Complex?

Oak Hill Park

- What color are the slides? Slide down them to be sure!
 - How many vertical poles make up the swing set? Go for a swing!

Rainbow Park

- How long does it take you to run from one end of the park to the other?
- Do you see any bees buzzing around yet, or is too cold?

Hatcher Hill Walking Trail

- What is the name of the cemetery at the beginning of the Hatcher Hill trail at the base of the hill?
- As you are walking up the hill, which way does the path curve?

Crooked Creek East Trail

- How many green steel posts hold up the highway bridge over the trail?
- Walk along the trail. Do you see or hear any signs of wildlife (buzzing insects, birds chirping, wildlife tracks, etc.)?
